Throughout his public and private sector career, Mr. Ridge has received numerous honors, including the Woodrow Wilson Award, the Veterans of Foreign Wars’ Dwight D. Eisenhower Award, the John F. Kennedy National Award, the Ellis Island Medal of Honor and the American Bar Association’s John Marshall Award.
